2021 Project Highlights

Western Ontario Project in Partnership with the Western Ontario Wardens' Caucus

Through our partnership with the **Western Ontario Wardens' Caucus**, Western Ontario was added to the ConnectON map! This included mapping agri-food and manufacturing assets for 10 new municipalities and updating data for 5 existing partner municipalities. Over 80 users in Western Ontario have access to the platform with 32, 486 data points mapped.

Northern Ontario Project in Partnership with the Northern Policy Institute

In partnership with the **Northern Policy Institute**, Northern Ontario was added to the ConnectON map completing the provincial picture in the platform! Agri-food and manufacturing assets were mapped for 11 districts and 6 separated cities. Also, a tourism pilot project was completed in tandem with the project, adding a third sector for Northern Ontario. This work was led by our tourism steering committee, a special thank you to Kevin Eshkawkogan – *Indigenous Tourism Ontario*, Ryan Reynard – *Lake of the Woods Business Incentive Corporation*, David MacLachlan – *Destination Northern Ontario*, Anna Demarchi-Meyers – *Halton Region*, and Chuck Thibeault – *Central Counties Tourism*. As a result of the overall project, 6, 945 assets were mapped in Northern Ontario.


Data Refresh

Keeping data current is important for maintaining data quality. Through 2021 the ConnectON team worked hard to refresh key data sources that could be used by all partners, and with individual municipalities on refreshing their municipal data. Here are the results:

2021 Overview



2021 was a year of growth and expansion for ConnectON! To summarize 2021, several system enhancements were made to the platform and ConnectON expanded to include 27 new areas and 125 new users. Between the data refreshes for existing partners and the 2 projects, we have over **60 areas** mapped resulting in **250+ users** engaged with the platform.

Across all three sectors ConnectON has a total of **116**, **403** assets mapped.

Through our continued partnerships and collaborations ConnectON is always growing.


Data Sharing Agreements and Addendum

We are pleased to report a new data sharing agreement with OMAFRA and the GHFFA was signed, providing our partners access to farm, food and beverage data through the ConnectON platform. An addendum and updated appendices to the ConnectON Data Sharing Agreement between the GHFFA and municipal partners aligns both agreements. The changes are minor and include added definitions and clarity around the use of the OMAFRA data by partners and "associates" (ie. consultants that may be hired by partners). These are welcome updates and do not change the intent of the Data Sharing Agreement in any way. Please do not hesitate to contact us with any questions.

ConnectON System Enhancements

New Regional Views

To support regional collaboration and partnerships, and with the addition of Western and Northern Ontario; 24 new regional views have been added to the ConnectON platform. A regional view for Western Ontario, inclusive of the WOWC member municipalities was established, and a regional view of Northern Ontario was added. Also, regional views such as regional tourism organizations and economic clusters were created. Check out the new regional views in the *Area* drop down menu.



Data Source Added to Asset Information

Another recent system enhancement was the addition of the *Data Source* to the *Asset Information*. This is an excellent reference to have readily available in the asset information, as it allows users to identify the source of the data: a municipality; a third party; an open source; a federal, provincial or other government agency; OMAFRA's farm business registry; or an Indigenous data source. This information can be accessed by clicking the *Asset Identifier* in the *Toolbar* and then clicking on a dot on the map.
